In 2011, my life was changed forever. I read about a young man who took his own life due to years of bullying and struggles with mental illness. The moment I first read about Jamie Hubley, I knew life was going to take me on an unexpected journey. This is when the idea of ‘Bullying Ends Here’ was imagined. I began speaking to classrooms about my own life story and how I was able to persevere. Speaking in classrooms led to audiences in the thousands and at locations all around the world. I had been asked many times to write a book to which I wrote my first one in 2017 entitled ‘Bullying Ends Here - My Life’. In 2020, I released my second book named ‘Bullying Ends Here - Walking the Talk’. Both have turned into best sellers! I have been fortunate enough to be in a position to help those who need it most through sharing my own story and connecting with those who are struggling in silence. I am able to balance my full-time police work with the added tasks of running a charity as large as Bullying Ends Here. Passion is a word that I would use to describe where the drive and energy come from. Every message I receive inspires, and reminds me, why speaking up is so important.
